3. Entries

- 3.1. Entries may be made by the World Athletics Member Federations or by individuals affiliated with the World Athletics Member Federations.
- 3.2. All entries must be made in writing, by email to ilgin.yuksel@taf.org.tr, accompanied by the passport copies of the proposed athletes. A phone number must be provided along with the entries for the purpose of setting up a WhatsApp group to be used as a means of delivering information to the participants.
- 3.3. The deadline for the entries is 14:00 CET, 18 February 2025. No additional athletes will be accepted after the closing of the Final Entries.
- 3.4. Final confirmations shall be made at the Technical Meeting.

4. Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will be held at 18:00 on Friday, 21 February. The venue and its location will be advised to the participants via the WhatsApp group of the event. Bib numbers will be delivered to the participants at the Technical Meeting.

5. Bib Numbers

- 5.1. Every athlete will be provided with two bib numbers which, during the competition, shall be worn visibly on the front of the torso and on the back.



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5.2. Bibs must be worn as issued and may not be cut, folded or obscured in any way. Except in the 5km race, the bibs may be perforated to assist the circulation of air, but the perforation must not be made on any of the lettering or numerals which appear on them.

6. Disqualification

6.1. A Penalty Zone will be used for all races. Athletes will be required to enter the Penalty Zone and remain there for the applicable period once they have received three Red Cards and are so advised by the Chief Judge, or the Judge delegated by the Chief Judge.

6.2. The applicable period in the Penalty Zone shall be as follows:

Race distance	Time
5km	0.5 min
10km	1 min
20km	2 min
35km	3.5 min

6.3. An athlete who fails to enter the Penalty Zone when required to do so, or remain there for the applicable period, shall be disqualified by the Referee.

6.4. If an athlete receives a third Red Card and it is no longer practicable to direct him/her to enter the Penalty Zone before the end of the race, the Referee shall add the time that would be spent in the Penalty Zone to the finishing time of the athlete and adjust the finishing order as may be necessary.

6.5. If an athlete receives an additional Red Card from a Judge other than one of the three who had previously sent a Red Card, he/she will be disqualified.

6.6. The Chief Judge has the power to disqualify an athlete in the last 100m, when the athlete's mode of progression obviously fails to comply with Rule 54.2 of the World Athletics Technical Rules regardless of the number of previous Red Cards the Chief Judge has received on that athlete. An athlete who is disqualified by the Chief Judge under these circumstances will be allowed to finish the race.

7. Drinking and Refreshment Stations

7.1. For the 5km and 10km races, water-only drinking stations will be provided at 1km intervals.

7.2. For the 20km and 35km races, refreshment stations will be provided at 1km intervals.

7.3. Personal refreshments should be taken to the station by the representatives of the athletes. A maximum of two officials per World Athletics Member Federation may be stationed at any time behind the table when the Federation is represented by up to three athletes. For the 20km and 35km races in which there are more than three athletes from the same Federation, a third official will be allowed behind the table for that Federation.

8. Training

The race course will be open for official training on Friday, 21 February, from 10:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 16:00.

9. Victory Ceremonies

The victory ceremonies for the top three ranked athletes will take place at the venue approximately within 40 minutes after the top three athletes finish in each race. The schedule of the victory ceremonies will be announced with the final timetable of the event.

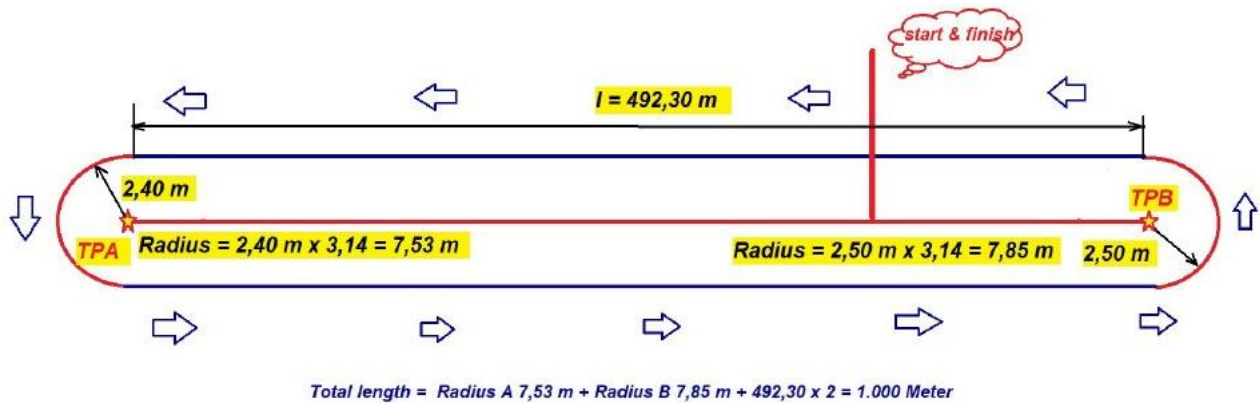
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10. Awards

Top three ranked athletes in the 20km and 35km, men and women separately, will receive prize money of USD 300, USD 250 and USD 200 respectively.

11. Race Course

The circuit of all the races is 1km. It is a World Athletics certified course, eligible for records and achieving entry standards of major championships. The map of the course is as follows:
